The need for a Come and See Resource

Young people are constantly pondering the big questions of life; why do I exist? what is life really about? Many are also curious about the existence of a God, the person of Jesus and the faith they see in others. Helping these young people find and unwrap the gifts of spirituality and faith within them requires a process of discovery, a journey into the unknown. Along the way the young people meet biblical characters, explore new perspectives, gain valuable insights about God, Jesus and the Christian faith. The journey will shed new light on historical events and the wisdom of the Church. Most importantly, the openness to share and evidence of lived faith of those accompanying the young people, will inspire them to become lifelong missionary disciples.

Resources successfully used by parish catechists to prepare children and adults for the Sacraments of Initiation can be a useful starting point. However, most are not suited to the interactive style of learning teenagers require. The **Come and See** resource are specifically designed aiming to nurture faith and a true sense of belonging to the church founded by Jesus Christ. The ones designed for use with older teenagers are also suitable for use with adults.

A Nation-Wide Initiative

Diocese across Australia have developed resources to welcome and prepare young people for the Christian life. In doing so, each has taken account of the particular circumstances and catechetical practices within their diocese.

The 'Come and See' materials developed in Perth build on and complement those produced in Queensland, NSW and Victoria. The combined efforts have created a comprehensive range of materials for use with three different age groups. The length of the meeting increases progressively, catering for the developmental needs of each. All encourage interaction and sharing.

Young Adolescents 9-12 years (1 hour)
 Young Teens 12-15 years (1.5 hours)
 Older Teens 15-18 years (2 hours)

Resources are available for each age group during the four stages of the Rite of Christian Initiation process.

Brisbane - Resources include Catechist notes with links to music, video and suggestions for follow up work. A workbook is available for Young Adolescents.

Perth - Resources include Catechist notes with plenty of additional background materials, some handouts and activity sheets for the young people.

A set of powerpoints is also available for the Inquiry Steps for Older Teens.
